John V. Farwell (pictured below) was captain of the freshman and varsity track teams in 1916 and 1917. One of the original 12 First Yale Unit members, Farwell later served with the Second Yale Unit at Buffalo and became a Squadron Commander at Pensacola NAS. He also served as an ordinance officer at Trojan, France, and was in Paris among massive jubilant French crowds that flooded the Place de la Concorde for four days after the Armistice was signed.
